



Setting up Entourage 2008:


1. Open Entourage 2008 and follow steps as per the screens below.



2. Following screen will be displayed. Please select “Exchange”



3. On the next screen enter the e-mail address and then click on **“Configure Account manually”** as given in the screenshot below.



4. On the next screen, start by entering your **"Display Name"** and your email address.

The **"Domain"** should always be specified as **APPS4RENT**, and for your **"Account ID"**, enter your SAM Name. Enter your password and click **"OK"**.

You can get the SAM Name from your [control panel](#). After logging into the control panel, you need to click on the name of the user in the control panel. You will get the SAM Name under the **"Account Info"** block of your control panel.

- For the final step, ensure that the **Public Folder** link is set up correctly by choosing **Tools** and then **Accounts**. Double-click your Exchange account, and click the "**Advanced**" tab. The settings should be same as shown below.
